### OUR REGISTRATION PROCESS:

**ALL STUDENTS:** At the time of application to St. Philip School, all families are required to provide copies of a student's **birth certificate, Baptismal and First Communion certificates** (if applicable), **and a current physical/immunization record**. If a student is accepted to St. Philip School, a non-refundable registration fee will be required within one week after notification of acceptance.

**PRE-KINDERGARTEN:** Admission is currently first-come, first served for our full day Pre-Kindergarten program. Parents must choose between a two day, three day, or five day option at the time of application. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis beginning each November until the program has reached its maximum capacity.

**KINDERGARTEN APPLICANTS:** Parents of prospective applicants must schedule an appointment for an admission interview with school administrators. Parents may call between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. beginning the week of January 10<sup>th</sup> to schedule an appointment. **Meetings will take place on Feb. 1, 3, 9 & 10 between 2:00-5:00 p.m. and 6:00-8:00 p.m. and each meeting will last approximately 15-20 minutes.**

**GRADES 1-8:** Applicants must provide the **most recent report card and any standardized testing results**. We also require **2 written recommendations: one from the applicant's current principal and one from a current teacher**. Upon receipt of all materials, an administrator from St. Philip School will contact families to set up a meeting and arrange for their children to visit the school for a day.
